









Composition of Monthly Podcast Listeners








Composition of Black Monthly Podcast Listeners Employment








Composition of Black Monthly Podcast Listeners Education














How Black monthly podcast listeners discovered podcasts when they started listening








What attracted Black monthly podcast listeners to the <u>first</u> podcast they listened to?





Which of the following are reasons why you stopped listening to a podcast you used to listen to regularly? % saying yes





Do you personally know a friend, relative, or colleague that produces their own podcast? % saying yes








Do you regularly listen to a podcast produced by a friend, relative, or colleague?








Locations where Black monthly podcast listeners listen to podcasts










Location where Black monthly podcast listeners listen to podcasts <u>most often</u>














How important is it to Black monthly podcast listeners that podcasts...?

% saying "very important" or "somewhat important"














Composition of Monthly vs Weekly Podcast Listeners Gender








Which of the following topics did you listen to on a podcast in the last year to learn more about it?

% listened to topic in the last year










Top 10 topics Women Black weekly podcast listeners ever listen to








Top 10 topics Men Black <u>weekly</u> podcast listeners ever listen to




























If you heard an advertisement for a brand on a podcast with Black hosts, how likely would you be to...?





What is your opinion of podcasting advertising that uses...?




